



EF Carpet(s) Warranty

Ten (10) Year Limited Manufacturing Defect Warranty

Carpet is warranted against manufacturing defects that are not visible and apparent prior to installation for the duration of the warranty. Manufacturing defects pertain to any defect in carpet material or workmanship by the manufacturer. Excluded from this warranty is carpet installed with visible irregularities, examples of which includes streaks, stop marks, high and low tufted rows, shear marks, poor shearing, dye spots, poor mends and missing tufts. Carpet received with visible irregularities should not be cut, altered, or installed.

Ten (10) Year Limited Residential Wear Warranty

When properly installed and maintained as set forth in our warranties, your carpet will not experience excessive wear for the duration of this warranty period, starting from the date of original purchase. Excessive wear is defined as a countable loss of carpet pile fiber, 10% or greater, resulting from normal use, and is determined by pile yarn weight comparisons between the worn area of your carpet to non-trafficked areas. Conditions including, but not limited to crushing, matting, pilling, fuzzing and shedding do not indicate excessive wear.

Limited No Exclusion Residential Stain Warranty

Manufactured with Solution Dyed Polyester carpet fiber, which as demonstrated exceptional stain resistance, when properly installed, cleaned and maintained according to warranty carpet will resist all stains.

Ten (10) Year Limited Residential Fade Resistance Warranty

Carpet when property maintained will not fade due to sunlight exposure or from atmospheric conditions that result in a noticeable color change more than one (1) unit on the AATCC Grey Scale during the duration of this warranty. Carpet installed in areas subjected to sunlight at least 50% of daylight hours requires UV protection, such as window and door blinds, shades, curtains, shutters ad treatments to maintain your warranty rights.
